INSTALLATION OF OVERHEAD SIGNS ON I-30 IN TEXARKANA DELAYED DUE TO WEATHER

LITTLE ROCK (2-6) – The scheduled installation of overhead signs on Interstate 30 in Texarkana Wednesday night into Thursday morning has been delayed due to weather, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The installation of overhead signs on Interstate 30 has been rescheduled to take place on Thursday Night into Friday morning, weather permitting.

The overhead sign will span the eastbound lanes of Interstate 30 between the Jefferson Avenue and Highway 245 exits. Jefferson Avenue and Highway 245 will not be affected.

The project will begin Thursday, February 7th at 11:00 p.m. It will be complete by Friday, February 8th at 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic in the eastbound lanes of Interstate 30 may be stopped for short intervals up to 15 minutes.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
