HIGHWAY 267 INTERSECTION IN SEARCY GETTING UPGRADE

LITTLE ROCK (2-15) – An intersection on Highway 267 in Searcy will get an upgrade next week, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be installing new stop signs, advance warning signs and pavement markings at the intersection of Highway 267 (W. Lincoln Ave.), Pioneer Street, and Elm Street in Searcy. Once complete, the intersection will be a 4-Way Stop, instead of a 2-Way Stop. Traffic on Highway 267 will be required to stop.

The work is scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m., Wednesday, February 20th, weather permitting. It should be complete by 3:00 p.m. Motorists are urged to find an alternate route during this time.

As always, driver should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
