ACCIDENT CLEAN-UP ON INTERSTATE 40 REQUIRES TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES

LITTLE ROCK (2-20) -- Crews removing a tractor trailer involved in a Tuesday accident on Interstate 40 in Prairie County will require a lane closure this morning, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will require the east and west bound lanes to be closed at the 201 mile marker of Interstate 40 east of Hazen. The closure will begin at 8:00 a.m., Wednesday, February 20th. East bound traffic will be diverted at the 193 mile marker (Hazen exit south to Highway 70). The work should last approximately 1 hour. West bound traffic will be diverted at the 202 mile marker (Biscoe exit north to Highway 38).

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
