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RE-STRIPING POSTPONED ON INTERSTATE 430/630 INTERCHANGE

LITTLE ROCK (3-5) -- Crews have been forced to postpone re-striping pavement through the Interstate 430/630 (Big Rock) Interchange, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

This project is intended to maintain safe travel through the interchange by making all current pavement markings stand out from any removed markings. This will make them more visible, especially at night and during inclement weather conditions.

Workers have already replaced all raised markers. However, re-striping has been delayed twice due to poor weather conditions. Re-striping is now scheduled to begin Thursday, March 7th and continue through Friday, March 8th between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Affected areas include Interstate 630, Interstate 430, Shackelford Road, Financial Centre Parkway and associated ramps and merge lanes in the interchange area.

To avoid wet paint, motorists should not drive between the contractor's vehicles and a law enforcement vehicles with warning lights. Drivers are also urged to exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.

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
