IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 530 REQUIRE TRAFFIC SHIFT IN PULASKI COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (3-29) – Improvements on Interstate 530 will require a traffic shift beginning next week in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will require I-530 southbound traffic to shift to a northbound lane at Bingham Road in southern Pulaski County. The shift will extend to near the Highway 167 exit. Northbound and southbound traffic will be separated by a temporary concrete wall.

The change in traffic flow will begin Monday, April 1st. In the event of bad weather, the project will be delayed until the next day. It will continue for approximately 3 months while the bridge at Lorance Creek is replaced and the adjacent southbound lanes are reconstructed.

This project is one of 38 interstate rehabilitation jobs that will improve 455 miles of Arkansas' interstates over the coming years.
