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IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 530 REQUIRE TRAFFIC SHIFT IN PULASKI COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (4-3) – Improvements on Interstate 530 will require a traffic shift beginning Friday morning in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will require I-530 southbound traffic to shift to a northbound lane at Bingham Road in southern Pulaski County. The shift will extend to near the Highway 167 exit. Northbound and southbound traffic will be limited to one lane in each direction and will be separated by a temporary concrete wall.

The change in traffic flow will begin Friday, April 5th at 9:00 a.m. It will continue for approximately 3 months while the bridge at Lorance Creek is replaced and the adjacent southbound lanes are reconstructed.

This work had been scheduled to begin this week, but was postponed due to weather.

This project is part of the 2011 Interstate Rehabilitation Program that will improve 455 miles of Arkansas' Interstates over the coming years.
