REPAIRS TO SCOTT HAMILTON OVERPASS ON INTERSTATE 30 IN LITTLE ROCK COMPLETE

LITTLE ROCK (4-19) – Bridge repair that required the temporary closure of the Scott Hamilton overpass on Interstate 30 in Little Rock has been completed, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Traffic on the bridge is now fully open in both directions. Eastbound lanes on Interstate 30 that were closed during the repair process are open too. Westbound traffic was not affected.

The Scott Hamilton bridge is approximately 50 years old and 260 feet in length. It carries about 9,500 vehicles per day.
