CONSTRUCTION REQUIRES WEEKEND DETOUR AT “BIG ROCK” INTERCHANGE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (5-30) – Construction will require a weekend detour at the Interstate 430/630 (Big Rock) Interchange, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Workers will be hanging steel beams for a new bridge. This will require the closure of the southeast cloverleaf loop. Any drivers in the Financial Centre Parkway/Shackleford Road area wanting to go north on Interstate 430 will be detoured. Motorists will be directed south on Shackleford Road to Interstate 430 North. **For more information, see the attached map of the detour area.**

The detour will begin Friday, May 31st at 10:00 p.m. and continue until Monday, June 3rd at 5:00 a.m., weather permitting.
