SIGN MAINTENANCE REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE ON INTERSTATE 440 IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-7) – Maintenance on an electronic message board will require a temporary lane closure next week on Interstate 440 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will require the eastbound inside lane of Interstate 440 to be closed near mile marker 5, just before the Fourche Dam Pike Exit. The lane closure will be Tuesday, June 11th between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., weather permitting.

Traffic will be controlled using warning signs and cones. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
