BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE ON HIGHWAY 70 IN ST. FRANCIS COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-7) – A routine bridge inspection will require a lane closure next week on Highway 70 in St. Francis County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will be performed on the St. Francis River Bridge on Highway 70, five miles east of Forrest City. The lane closure will be Monday, June 10th through Thursday, June 13th between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., weather permitting. Vehicles over 9 feet wide will not be permitted to cross the bridge during that time.

Traffic will be controlled using warning signs and flaggers. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
