REPAIRS TO RAILROAD CROSSING REQUIRE CLOSURE OF HIGHWAY 51 CROSSING IN DONALDSON

LITTLE ROCK (6-14) – Repairs to a Union Pacific Railroad crossing will require the closure of the Highway 51 (Bryant Drive) crossing in Donaldson, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work by Union Pacific crews will require the closure on Monday, June 17th between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., weather permitting.

Traffic will be detoured using Highway 51B (North Front Street) on the east side of the railroad track. Motorists on the west side of the track will be detoured using Highway 67. Traffic flow will be controlled using warning signs and barrels. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
