BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE ON HIGHWAY 38 IN PRAIRIE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-21) – A routine bridge inspection will require a lane closure on Highway 38 in Prairie County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be performing the inspection on a White River relief bridge on Highway 38. It's located just east of the White River Bridge, east of Des Arc. The work will require a single lane closure on Monday, June 24th between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Only one travel lane will be open.

Traffic will be controlled using warning signs, cones, and flaggers. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
