REPAIRS TO INTERSTATE 40 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURE IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-21) – Pavement repairs will require a continued lane closure on Interstate 40 in North Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will be performed on Interstate 40 at the Young Road Overpass, which is just east of the Crystal Hill overpass at mile marker 149.

On March 7th, the overpass was hit by a tractor trailer causing extensive damage to the bridge and the shoulder of the Interstate. The bridge and guard rails have been repaired. Work is now focusing on the shoulder of the Interstate.

It will require the westbound outside lane to be closed Monday, June 24th through Thursday, June 27th between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

This work is expected to continue for the next 3 or 4 weeks. AHTD will provide lane closure advisories each Friday until the work is complete.

Traffic will be controlled using warning signs and barrels. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
