BRIDGE INSPECTIONS ON INTERSTATE 40 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN WEST MEMPHIS

LITTLE ROCK (7-26) - Routine bridge inspections on Interstate 40 will require lane closures in West Memphis, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be working on the Martin Luther King Drive and Mound City Road overpasses. The work will require Interstate 40 eastbound and westbound traffic to be merged into one lane from just east of the Interstate 40/55 interchange (mile marker 180) to just east of Mound City Road (mile Marker 181).

The lane closures will be Wednesday night, July 31st and Thursday night, August 1st between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
