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IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 30 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN CLARK & NEVADA COUNTIES

LITTLE ROCK (9-11) – Improvements to Interstate 30 will require lane closures in Clark and Nevada counties, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be resurfacing 13 miles of Interstate 30 to improve friction. The work will extend from Prescott, east to Highway 53 (Exit 63). The work will require the alternating closure of one lane in both directions of travel.

The closures will begin Thursday, September 12th at 7:00 a.m. They will continue during the daylight hours until the project is complete later this month, weather permitting. The speed limit will be reduced to 60 mph in the work zone and traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
