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## CONSTRUCTION REQUIRES LANE SHIFTS ON INTERSTATE 530 IN PULASKI COUNTY

**LITTLE ROCK (9-23)** – Construction will require new lane shifts on Interstate 530 in southern Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

**Tuesday, September 24<sup>th</sup>**, southbound traffic will be moved back into the southbound lanes onto a newly constructed bridge just south of Bingham Road. Northbound traffic will remain in the northbound outside lane while a concrete barrier wall is relocated to the southbound lanes.

On **Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup>**, northbound traffic will be moved to the southbound inside lane. This will reduce traffic to one lane in each direction for the next few months while the northbound bridge is reconstructed. Traffic will be controlled using a concrete barrier wall, barrels, and warning signs.

Crews are resurfacing 7.4 miles of I-530 southwest of Wrightsville. Cranford Construction Company, of North Little Rock, was awarded the contract at \$13,525,134.63. The entire project is scheduled to be complete by the summer of 2014.
