BRIDGE WORK WILL LIMIT BOAT NAVIGATION ON GREERS FERRY LAKE IN CLEBURNE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (10-18) - Bridge replacement work will limit boat navigation on Greers Ferry Lake in Cleburne County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews are replacing the Highway 225 (Sunny Slope Road) Bridge over Greers Ferry Lake. The bridge is located just east of Hill Creek Recreation Area. Workers will be moving large equipment and conducting small controlled explosive blasts at the lake bottom. During this time, navigation will be closed near the bridge.

The temporary closures will be Monday, October 21st through Friday, November 8th, except Sundays, weather permitting. The closures will be approximately 15-30 minutes long and will only occur during daylight hours.

The \$8 million dollar bridge replacement is expected to be complete by late 2014.
