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BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE ON HIGHWAY 365 IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (11-22) – A routine bridge inspection requires a lane closure on Highway 365 (MacArthur Drive) in North Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be inspecting the Highway 365 (MacArthur Drive) bridge located over Parkway Drive and railroad tracks. The work will require closing the westbound lane of Highway 365 (MacArthur Drive) at the bridge location. Traffic on Parkway Drive will not be affected.

The closures will occur Tuesday, November 26th through Wednesday, November 27th between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers, barrels and warning signs.

The bridge was constructed in 1941. It is 573 feet long and 36 feet wide. A 2013 study indicates an average of 9,500 vehicles use the bridge each day.
