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ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN ASHLEY COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-10) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Ashley County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and County Judge Dennis Holland.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 3.8 miles of roadway in Ashley County.

Pine Bluff Sand & Gravel Company of Pine Bluff, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$522,730.94.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Construction is scheduled begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete this summer.
