ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN STONE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (4-22) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission and County Judge Stacey Avey approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Stone County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 1 mile of County Road 21 (Luber Road). The work will extend 1 mile south of Highway 9, south of Mountain View.

Atlas Asphalt, Inc. of Batesville, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$140,108.36.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete this spring.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the country road system.
