ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CRAIGHEAD COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (8-4) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Bono and Brookland, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 3.4 miles of roadways in Bono and Brookland. The streets are listed below:

| Nearest town/County | Roadway | Location | Miles |

| Bono (Cleburne) | Alta St. | Extends east from Danny St. to Robin St. | 0.3 |
| Bono (Cleburne) | Carson St. | Extends east from Danny St. to Robin St. | 0.3 |
| Bono (Cleburne) | Michael St. | Extends south from S. Main St. to Danny St. | 0.1 |
| Bono (Cleburne) | E. Oak St. | Extends east from N. Main St. to Wyatt St. | 0.2 |
| Bono (Cleburne) | Robin St. | Extends south from E. College St. to Michael St. | 0.2 |
| Bono (Cleburne) | Wyatt St. | Extends south from E. Oak St. to E. College St. | 0.2 |
| Brookland (Cleburne) | N. Bernis | Extends north from Stevens Ave. to W. School St. | 0.5 |
| Brookland (Cleburne) | Barnett/Missouri St. | Extends north from E. Mathews St. to E. School St. | 0.5 |
| Brookland (Cleburne) | S. Oak St. | Extends south from W. School St. to Stevens Ave. | 0.5 |

Atlas Asphalt of Batesville, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$409,905.15.

This project is being funded through the State Aid City Streets Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist cities with projects selected by a nine-member panel of Arkansas mayors.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete this summer.
