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### **ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN RANDOLPH COUNTY**

**LITTLE ROCK (8-4)** - The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Randolph County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to replace drainage structures on County Road 70 (Middlebrook Rd.). The areas are listed below:

Town	Roadway	Location
N. of Maynard	Middlebrook Rd.	Just west of Odom Rd. (0.9 mile east of Hwy. 115)
N. of Maynard	Middlebrook Rd.	Just west of Mile Rd. (1.8 miles east of Hwy 115)

Kesser International, Inc. of Little Rock, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$114,776.49.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid County Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete this summer.
