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ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN WOODRUFF COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-10) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Woodruff County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and County Judge Charles Dallas.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 10 miles of roadway in Woodruff County.

Co. Rd. 1/58/935	Extends south from Hwy. 38	W. of Cotton Plant	2.4
Co. Rd. 52	Extends east from Hwy. 269 to Co. Rd. 381	NE of McCrory	1.6
Co. Rd. 60	Extends west of Hwy 49	W. of Hunter	6

Salt Creek Paving & Construction Company, Inc. of Benton, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$303,232.24.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Construction is scheduled begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete on or before October 15th.
