ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN FULTON COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (9-22) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Fulton County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and Fulton County Judge Charles Willett. The purpose of the project is to resurface 2.8 miles of County Road 39 and 64. The locations are listed below.

W. of Mammoth Spring	Co. Rd. 64 (Fairview Rd.)	Extends S. from near Meadowview Ln.	0.9

Atlas Asphalt, Inc. of Batesville, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$395,102.65.

Construction is scheduled begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The job should be complete by December 19, 2014.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.
