Highway 22 Lane Closures in Fort Smith

FORT SMITH (May 23) The Contractor has informed the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department District Four Headquarters at Fort Smith of planned lane closures associated with work to overlay Highway 22 (Rogers Avenue) in Fort Smith.

Beginning Tuesday, May 27th, lane closures may be expected, between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., in either the eastbound or westbound directions of Highway 22 (Rogers Avenue) from Garrison Avenue to I-540. No lane closures are anticipated outside of the aforementioned times.

Adjustment of the times of any announced lane closures may become necessary due to weather or other unforeseen conditions.

In April 2014, the Arkansas Highway Commission awarded a contract, in the amount of \$1.2 million, to Forsgren Inc. of Fort Smith, Arkansas. The project includes milling of the existing lanes, an asphalt overlay, and striping. Work on the project is expected to be complete by July 2014.

Motorists are urged to use care and think ahead when traveling through the work zone. They should remember to Obey the Posted Speed Limits and Other Regulatory Signing; to Maintain a Steady Speed; to Leave Room between them and other vehicles; to Be Aware of Road Conditions in front of them; and to Anticipate the Need to Stop or Reduce Speed Substantially.
