INSTALLATION OF FLOOD WARNING SIREN REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE ON CENTRAL AVENUE IN HOT SPRINGS

LITTLE ROCK (2-3) – Installation of a flood warning siren and pole will require a lane closure on Highway 7 (Central Avenue) in Hot Springs, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Hot Springs city crews will install the flood warning siren near the Arlington Hotel on Highway 7 (Central Avenue). The work will require closing the northbound outside lane near the hotel. Drivers will still have access to the hotel and surrounding businesses.

The lane closure will be Wednesday, February 5th between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using cones and warning signs.
