TESTING ON INTERSTATE 630 REQUIRES NIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (2-14) – Pavement testing on Interstate 630 will require night lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Wednesday, Feb. 19 – Thursday, Feb. 20

From 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., eastbound and westbound lanes and shoulders on I-630 will alternately be closed between the eastern ramps at the Baptist Hospital overpass and the University Avenue overpass bridge. Crews will rotate the lane closures to keep one or two lanes open in each direction throughout testing.

If the testing is not completed by 6 a.m., it will resume Thursday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Traffic will be controlled using reflective cones, message boards and arrow boards.

The work is being conducted to prepare for widening I-630 between Baptist Hospital and University Avenue. This project is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program. More information on this project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com
