SIGN REPLACEMENT REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE NEAR INTERSTATE 430/630 "BIG ROCK" INTERCHANGE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (2-21) – Sign replacement will require a lane closure on Interstate 430 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be replacing a sign on the Shackelford Road overpass. The work will reduce Interstate 430 northbound traffic to one lane.

The closure will be Tuesday night, February 25th, through Wednesday morning, February 26th between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

This work had been scheduled for Wednesday February 19th, but had to be postponed due to high winds.
