SIGN REPLACEMENT REQUIRES OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 430 IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (3-7) – Sign replacement will require overnight lane closures on Interstate 430 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be replacing a sign on the Shackelford Road overpass. The work will reduce Interstate 430 northbound traffic to one lane.

The closures will be Tuesday night, March 11th, through Wednesday morning, March 12th between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

This work had been scheduled for March 4th, but had to be postponed due to poor weather conditions.
