## **SIGN INSTALLATION REQUIRES OVERNIGHT LANE AND RAMP CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 630 IN LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (3-7)** – The installation of an overhead sign will require overnight lane and ramp closures on Interstate 630 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will complete the installation of a new sign on the Baptist Health overpass. This will reduce Interstate 630 westbound traffic to one lane and close the westbound I-630 entrance ramp. Drivers leaving Baptist Hospital who want to go west on Interstate 630 will be detoured to John Barrow Road to access westbound traffic.

The overnight closures will be Thursday night, March 13<sup>th</sup>, through Friday morning, March 14<sup>th</sup> between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning/detour signs.

This work had been scheduled for the previous week. However, it had to be rescheduled due to poor weather conditions.
