## WEIGHT SENSOR INSTALLATION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 40 IN LONOKE COUNTY

**LITTLE ROCK (5-2)** – Installation of a truck weight sensor will require lane closures on Interstate 40 in Lonoke County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be installing the truck weight sensors between the Lilly Road overpass and the Northcutt Road overpass, east of Lonoke. The work will require closing individual eastbound and westbound lanes between mile markers 177 and 179, weather permitting.
