IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 55 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN CRITTENDEN COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-5) – Improvements to Interstate 55 will require overnight lane closures in Crittenden County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will install raised pavement markers to replace those damaged during snow and ice removal. The work is being performed between mile markers 7 and 15, between the Interstate 40/55 Interchange and 2 miles south of the Highway 50 exit (Exit 17) near Clarkedale.

The **northbound** moving outside lane closure will be Tuesday night, May 6th through Wednesday morning, May 7th between 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., weather permitting.

The **southbound** moving outside lane closure will be Wednesday night, May 7th through Thursday morning, May 8th between 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., weather permitting.

Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
