IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAY 67 WILL REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN SALINE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-9) – Improvements to Highway 67 will require lane closures in Saline County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be resurfacing Highway 67. The work will extend from Highway 229 in Haskell to the Hot Spring County line. It will reduce traffic to one lane. Drivers are encouraged to reduce speed due to loose material on the highway during the resurfacing process.

The lane closures will be Tuesday, May 13th through Thursday, May 15th, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers and warning signs.
