### IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAYS WILL REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN ST. FRANCIS AND WOODRUFF COUNTIES

**LITTLE ROCK (5-30)** – Improvements to highways in St. Francis and Woodruff counties will require lane closures, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be sealing state highways at the locations listed below. Liquid asphalt and pea gravel will be used to seal cracks and provide a durable driving surface. Drivers are encouraged to reduce speed to 25 mph during the application process to avoid glass breakage from gravel kicked up by vehicles traveling too fast for conditions.

#### Woodruff County (June 2-16)

#### St. Francis County (June 9-16)

Highway 261	Horton to Caldwell	4.5
Highway 38	Hwy. 70 to Widener	2
Highway 50	Madison to Widener	2

The potential lane closures will be weekdays, Monday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> through Monday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers, cones and warning signs.
