IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAY 167-B REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN SHERIDAN

LITTLE ROCK (6-6) – Improvements to Highway 167-B will require lane closures in Sheridan, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will resurface 4 miles of Highway 167-B, in Sheridan. The work will extend south from Highway 270 (Center Street) in Sheridan to just north of the new Highway 167 Bypass. The work will reduce traffic to one lane.

The lane closures will be Monday, June 9th through Thursday, July 3rd. The work will only be performed Mondays through Fridays between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers, cones, and warning signs.

Cranford Construction Company of North Little Rock, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$1,058,671.23.
