## **BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON HIGHWAY 67 IN DONALDSON**

**LITTLE ROCK (6-4)** – A routine bridge inspection will require lane closures on Highway 67 in Donaldson, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will inspect the bridge over Pine Street and the Union Pacific railroad tracks in northern Donaldson. The work will reduce traffic to one lane.

The lane closures will be Wednesday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers, cones, and warning signs.

This 80 year old bridge is scheduled to be replaced. Bids will be accepted from contractors in late this year or early next year. The current bridge was built in 1934. It is 615 feet long and 27 feet wide.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
