## IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAY 278 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN DREW COUNTY

**LITTLE ROCK (7-9)** – Improvements to Highway 278 will require lane closures in Drew County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be replacing drainpipes beneath Highway 278. The work will be performed about 4 miles south of the Highway 278/Highway 277 intersection between Monticello and McGehee. It will reduce traffic to one lane within the work zone.

The lane reduction will be Monday, July 14 through Wednesday, July 16th, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels, warning signs, and flaggers.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
