## **SIGN INSTALLATION REQUIRES OVERNIGHT RAMP CLOSURE BETWEEN I-430 AND I-630 IN LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (7-9)** - Sign installation will require an overnight ramp closure between Interstate 430 and Interstate 630 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be hanging overhead signs. The work will require closing the I-430 southbound to I-630 eastbound loop ramp in Little Rock. Traffic will be detoured to Shackleford Road to access I-630 eastbound.

The ramp closure will be Wednesday night, July 9th through Thursday morning, July 10<sup>th</sup>, between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs. This work had been scheduled for Tuesday night, but was delayed due to rain.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
