IMPROVEMENTS WILL REQUIRE CLOSURE OF HIGHWAY 36 IN WHITE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-21) – Improvements will require closing Highway 36 to traffic in White County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will install a double cross drain that was damaged during recent flooding. It will require closing Highway 36 between West Point and Georgetown.

The closure will occur at 7:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 23rd until Thursday, July 24th at 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Drivers to Georgetown will be detoured using Jones Island Road. Traffic will be controlled using barrels, warning and detour signs. Drivers will be directed to Jones Island Road to access Georgetown.
