## BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON HIGHWAY 70 IN GARLAND COUNTY

**LITTLE ROCK (8-1)** – A routine bridge inspection will require lane closures on Highway 70 in Garland County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will inspect the bridge over the Gulpha Creek and Malvern Avenue, located just east of Hot Springs. The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound outside lanes on Highway 70 (Martin Luther King Bypass).

- **The eastbound outside lane closure will be Monday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon, weather permitting.**
- **The westbound outside lane closure will be Monday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, between 12:00 noon and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.**

Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
