IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAY 46 WILL REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN GRANT COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (9-25) – Improvements to Highway 46 will require lane closures in Grant County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be resurfacing sections of Highway 46. The work will occur between Leola and the intersection of Highway 46 and Highway 190. The work will reduce traffic to one lane within the work zone.

The lane closures will be Monday, September 29th through Thursday, October 2nd, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
