IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAY 425 WILL REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN LINCOLN COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (9-25) – Improvements to Highway 425 will require lane closures in Lincoln County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be resurfacing sections of Highway 425. The work will extend north from near Star City to the Jefferson County Line. The work will reduce traffic to one lane within the work zone.

The lane closures will be Monday, October 6th through Friday, October 10th, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
