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### **BRIDGE INSPECTIONS REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES AT HIGHWAY 440/67 INTERCHANGE IN JACKSONVILLE**

**LITTLE ROCK (9-26)** – Routine bridge inspections will require lane closures at the Highway 440/67 Interchange near Jacksonville, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be inspecting the Highway 67 southbound to Highway 440 southbound overpass and the Highway 440 northbound to Highway 67 southbound overpass. The work will reduce traffic to one lane.

The lane closure for the Highway 67 southbound to Highway 440 southbound overpass will be inspected on **Tuesday, September 30<sup>th</sup>** between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. This bridge was constructed in 2002. It is 2,870 feet long and 40 feet wide.

The lane closure for the Highway 440 northbound to Highway 67 southbound overpass will be **Wednesday, October 1<sup>st</sup>**, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs. This bridge was constructed in 2002. It is 1,574 feet long and 25 feet wide.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
