AHTD TO HOLD PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING IN SHARP COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (10-10) - The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Public Involvement Meeting in Hardy to discuss plans to replace three bridges on Highway 63.

The three bridges are located on Highway 63 between the City of Hardy and the community of Ozark Acres. The bridges are considered functionally obsolete and need upgrades to meet future traffic needs.

The meeting will be held Thursday, October 16th, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at Hardy City Hall, 124 Woodland Hills Road in Hardy.
