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PAVEMENT RESEARCH REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 30 IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (10-10) – Pavement research will require lane closures on Interstate 30 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be taking geo-technical samples on Interstate 30. The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound outside lanes between Geyer Springs Road and 65th Street (mile markers 133-135). Work will begin on the eastbound lane and then move to the westbound lane.

The lane closures will be Tuesday, October 14th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
