## IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAY 138 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN DREW COUNTY

**LITTLE ROCK (10-13)** – Improvements to Highway 138 will require lane closures in Drew County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be replacing drainage pipes that are beneath Highway 138. The work will be performed 2 miles west of the Highway 65 intersection at Winchester. The work will reduce eastbound and westbound traffic to one lane. Drivers need to be aware that a gravel patch will be placed over the repaired section. An asphalt patch will be placed the final day of work.

The closures will be Monday, October 20<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers, barrels and warning signs.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
