WORK WILL REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 40 IN LONOKE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (10-28) – Work will require lane closures on Interstate 40 in Lonoke County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be spot treating invasive plants along the route for vegetation control. The work will reduce traffic to one lane in small moving sections between mile markers 164 and 183 or from the Pulaski County line to just west of Carlisle.

The eastbound or westbound lane closures will be Wednesday, October 29^h, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using message boards, arrow panels and warning signs.
