BRIDGE INSPECTIONS REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 440 IN PULASKI COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (10-31) – Routine bridge inspections will require lane closures on Interstate 440 in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be inspecting I-440 northbound and southbound bridges over the Union Pacific Railroad, in southern Jacksonville.

The northbound outside lane will be closed Monday, November 3rd and Tuesday, November 4th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. The southbound outside lane will be closed Thursday, November 6th and Friday, November 7th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Both bridges were constructed in 2002. The northbound bridge is 2,042 feet in length and 56 feet in width. The southbound bridge is 2,001 feet in length and 67 feet in width.
