IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 40 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN PRAIRIE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (11-14) – Sweeping will require lane closures on Interstate 40 in Prairie County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be sweeping litter and debris that has accumulated along the barrier wall in an area between Hazen and Biscoe. The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound inside lanes between mile markers 198 and 202.

The eastbound inside lane closure will be Wednesday, November 19th between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. The westbound inside lane will be closed Thursday, November 20th between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
