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### **PAVEMENT TESTING REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON U.S. HIGHWAY 67 IN PULASKI AND LONOKE COUNTIES**

**LITTLE ROCK (11-18)** – Pavement research will require daytime lane closures on U.S. Highway 67 in Pulaski and Lonoke counties, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will perform pavement testing on the northbound and southbound shoulders of Highway 67, extending from West Main Street in Jacksonville to Highway 5 in Cabot. Depending on which shoulder is being tested, an inside or outside lane will also be closed.

The lane closures will be Thursday, November 20<sup>th</sup> and Friday, November 21<sup>st</sup>, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and warning signs.

The work will require a northbound lane and shoulder closure on Thursday, first on the outside lane and then the inside lane. A southbound lane and shoulder will be closed on Friday, first on the outside lane and then on the inside lane.
